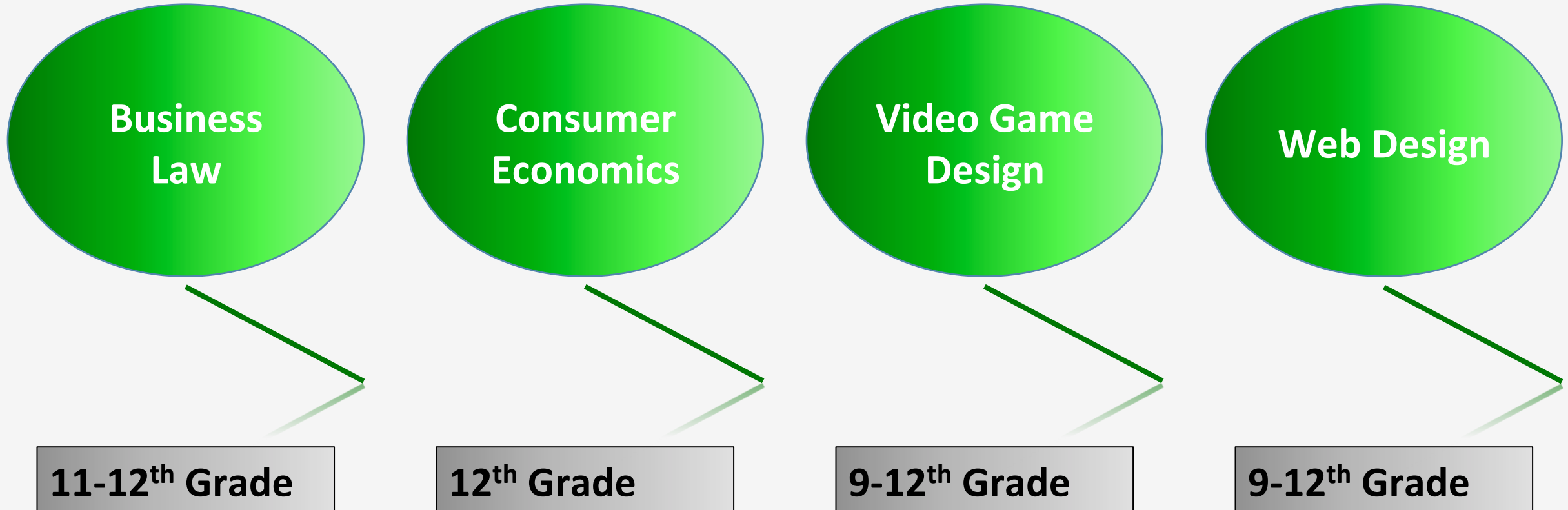


Online Courses

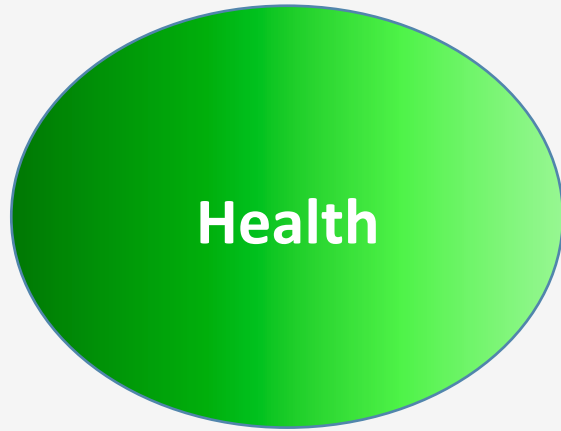

Online Health Course

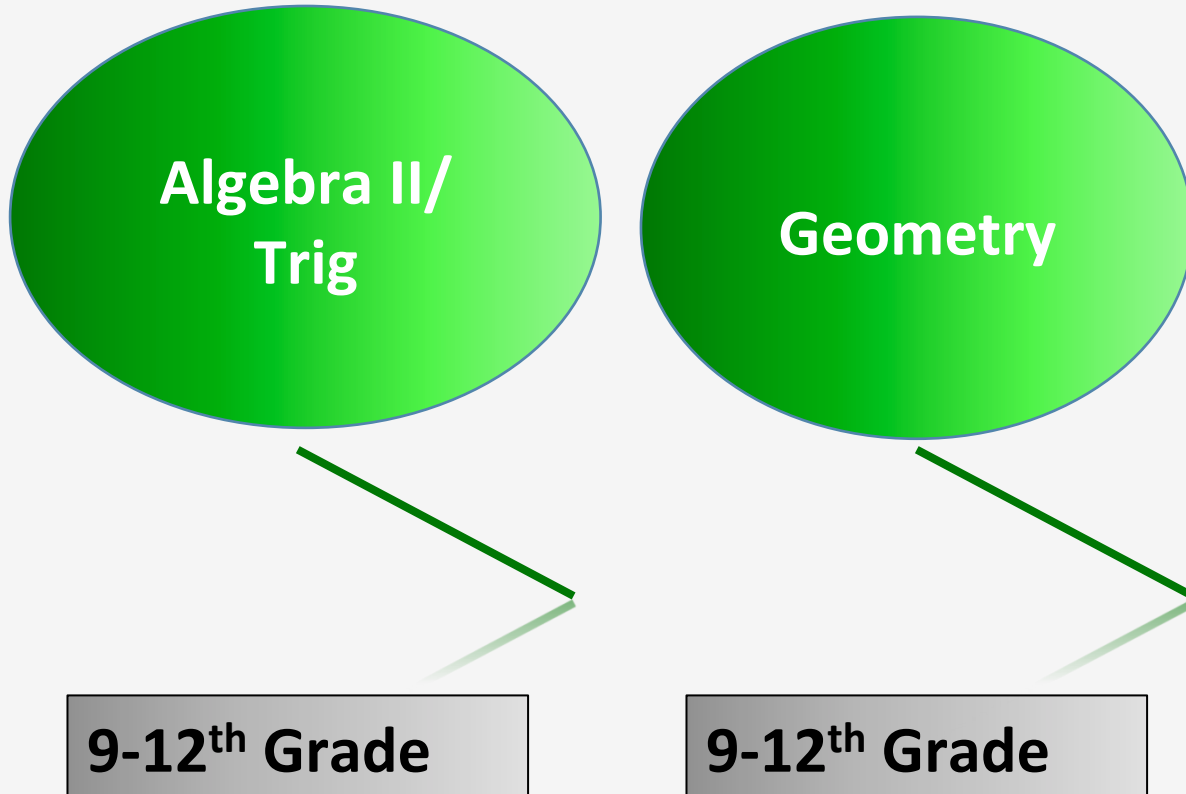

Online Music Theory Course



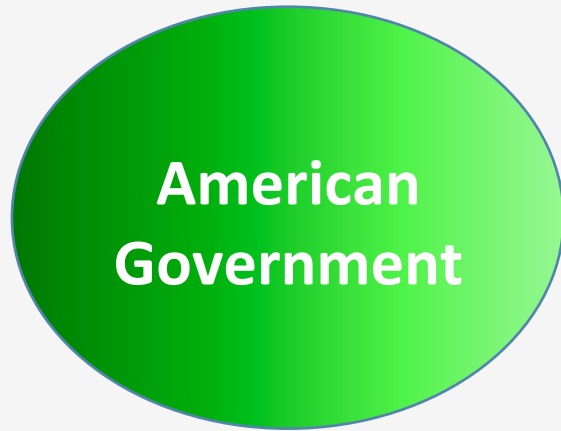

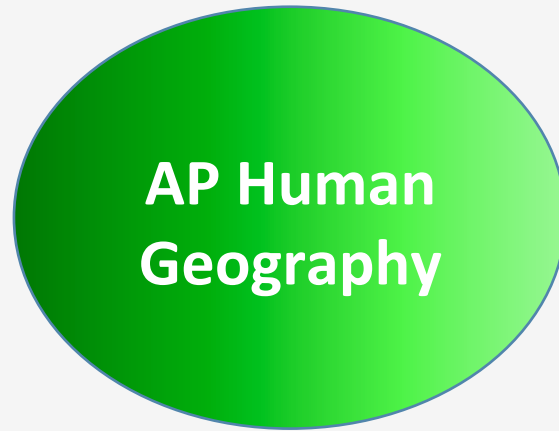
About the Course


