

<p>Neuqua Valley High School Guidance Department SUMMER COURSE OPTIONS</p>

- Preapproved courses taken outside the district will be posted to the transcript as a letter grade and count towards the student's Grade Point Average (GPA). Outside courses are **not eligible** for weighted credit.
- Students are responsible for following the provider deadlines set forth for course completion.
- Any coursework not pre-approved will not be placed on the D204 transcript. **See counselor for preapproval form prior to registering and paying for the course.**
- Students are limited to 2.0 maximum credits during 4 years, using any outside providers; any course work taken beyond the 2.0 credits will not be reported on our transcript or used to meet graduation requirements.
- Courses taken through outside providers are **not** on IPSD 204's NCAA list of approved courses (48H Form). Any college-bound athlete should research this option carefully.

- End of course grade release form required by Illinois Virtual
- Courses must be completed by August 8th or August 15th. They are NOT 17 weeks in length

- Begin course same day as enrolling
- Fee payable directly to BYU
- Coursework for seniors: transcripts must be received by May 1st, in order to participate in the graduation ceremony--- (so course must be completed by April 15th)
